NOTES FOR COMPETITIONS

- All the Nursery students must take part in all the competitions as mentioned in the CCA Calendar 2018-19
- A student of LKG to XII can take part in all the mass competitions. But he/she can take part in maximum 3 selective competitions. Nursery, LKG, UKG and class I to IV will have class wise competitions. But, classes V to XII will have group wise competitions. Groups are V-VI, VII-VIII, IX-X and XI-XII. All mass competitions are compulsory for all. The competition dates are final. If any last minute change takes place, will be rescheduled and to be informed in advance.
- The topic for theme show for LKG:- Animals/Flowers/Birds and for UKG :-Vegetables/ Great Personality/Our Helpers.
- The participants of Sit & Draw competition for LKG & UKG are not allowed to use any kind of tools like scale, bangle, compass etc. for this competition. The child will draw with free hand only. Accordingly a child should practise in advance.
- The participants of See & Tell Competition for LKG & UKG have to observe the objects / given things and then they have to tell about the things that they have seen.
- The participants of Rhymes, Prayer Recitation and Shanti Path for LKG and UKG will go through a preliminary round initially. Those who will qualify in preliminary round they can only take part in the final round. The dates for final round for Rhymes-28.08.18, Shanti Path-30.10.18 and Prayer Recitation-11.12.18
- Students participating in “Memory Test” Competition for classes I and II have to observe the things given and then they have to write them on a sheet of paper.
- The topic for English speech and Paragraph writing for class III and IV will be given two days prior to the competition.
- Students participating in “Making of Jewellery Box” Competition for class III and IV should use shoes box and other decorative items. They should not put any jewellery in the box.
- Students participating in “Toy making with cotton” for class V-VI can use cotton, chumki, stone, lace and other decorative items.
- Students participating in “Making of Menu Card for Healthy Food” competition for class V-VI will get folded A4 size chart paper from the school. They have to bring the colouring materials and decorate the front page of the card. Finished materials from the market must be avoided for decoration. In the next page, they have to write ten healthy starter dishes and ten healthy main course items for vegetarian lunch.
- The topic for English essay writing, Hindi speech, Hindi debate, English elocution, English debate for classes V to XII will be given one day prior to the competition.
- The topic for Extempore speech for class VII-VIII will be given to all the participants 5 minutes prior to the competition.
- Students participating in Pot Painting competition for class IX-X may use single base colour without any marks or outline on the pot prior to the competition. Only painting will be allowed during competition time. No student can paste anything. They can use added properties like flowers, stand etc. for presentation.
- For Birthday Card Making, Toy Making with Cotton, Making of Jewellery Box and Pot Painting competitions the participants must bring the materials in the raw form and assemble them in the school within the allotted time. Finished materials from the market are strictly prohibited.
- It is compulsory for all the students to participate in Maths Aptitude Test for class IX-X and Mental Ability Test for class XI-XII. There will be 100 questions and the time limit is 120 minutes.
- It is compulsory for all the students to participate in Mathematical Reasoning for class VII- VIII. There will be 60 questions and the time limit is 90 minutes.
- The topic for Seminar/PPT/Documentary presentation will be given one week before the competition.
- The topic for dance competition for class III and IV:-Patriotic, V-VI:-Devotional, VII-VIII:-Folk, IX-X:-Semi-classical. The participants of Dance competition should avoid risky properties like fire and sharp objects. To avoid the repetition of same song for dance, the CD of first student will only be accepted. No other student can perform dance on the same song. Interested students may confirm their song as early as possible.
- There will be Grand Finale for Dance Competition for the first and second position holders from class III-X for Best Dancer, Runners up Award, Best Costume Award, Best Entertainer Award, Best use of properties and Best Theme Award from the whole lot of class III to X. Each finalist will be allotted 4+1 mins. for his/her performance. The duration for dance competition is 4 minutes. Additional 1 minute will be given for stage preparation for each participant. So, a participant will be allowed 5 minutes time in total for stage preparation followed by dance. Under any circumstance stage preparation time and dance duration should not exceed 5 minutes.
- There will be a Grand Finale for song competition among the first and second position holders from class V to X for Championship, Expert’s Choice and Runners up Award during Children’s Fest. The participants may use their own suitable track or life on their own arrangement. The participants without Life/Track will also be judged.
- The participants of Photography competition must bring their camera. The memory chip must be blank.
- For all the competitions a participant must manage the allotted time strictly.
- The Children’s Fest will be held on 14.11.2018(Wednesday), 15.11.2018(Thursday) and 16.11.2018 (Friday).

RULES FOR SPECIAL PRIZES

- ❖ CCA Champion (for Nursery): A student must have to win three 1st prizes out of all seven competitions.
- ❖ CCA Champion (for Classes LKG to XII): A student must have to win four 1st prizes out of total competitions of mass and selective.
- ❖ Sports Champion (for Classes Nursery to IV): A student must have to win three 1st prizes in sports.
- ❖ Sports Champion (for Classes V to XII): A student must have to win four 1st prizes in sports.
- ❖ All Rounder: To be given as per competition group, if in any case nobody confirms minimum eligibility, the award will be cancelled for that group.

Minimum eligibility for a student:

- Must secure 85% or above (in Annual Exam of the previous session and Half Yearly Exam of the current session.)
 - Prizes in Annual Athletic Meet.
 - Maximum number of prizes in Indoor competitions.
 - Active participation in school activities like House, Clubs etc.
 - General behavior towards teachers, seniors and juniors. (More factors relating to the student - school surrounding may be taken into consideration.)
 - In case of tie, the performance in outdoor competitions, parents involvement towards the growth of the school etc. will be taken into consideration.
- ❖ Full Attendance (for Classes Nursery to V) : There will be no full attendance prize.
 - ❖ Full Attendance (for Classes VI to XII) : A student must enter the school before the first bell rings and leave the school after the last bell rings.
 - ❖ Best Kid (for Classes Nursery, LKG & UKG) : A student must either be an All-Rounder or CCA Champion or Sports Champion. Besides he/she should be good at academics, regular, punctual and shows interest and actively participates in school activities.
 - ❖ Besides these, Literary, Best volunteer, Discipline and Student of the Year awards will be given basing on overall qualities of the students.

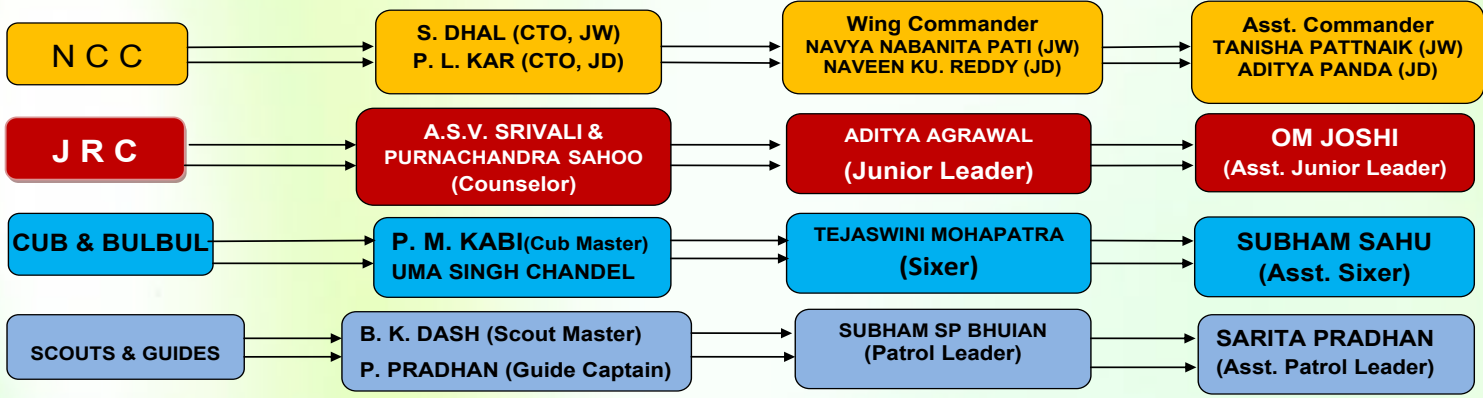
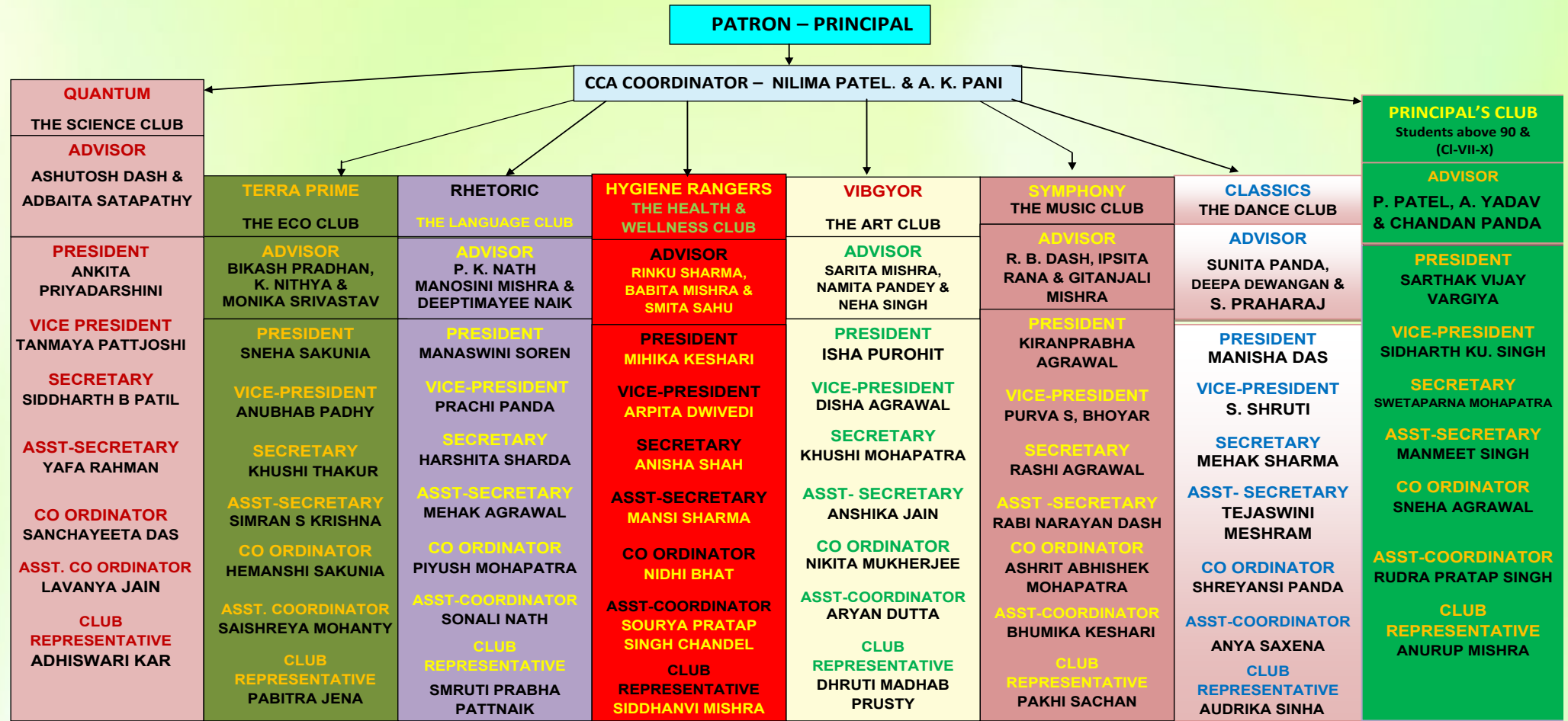
INTER-HOUSE ACTIVITIES
